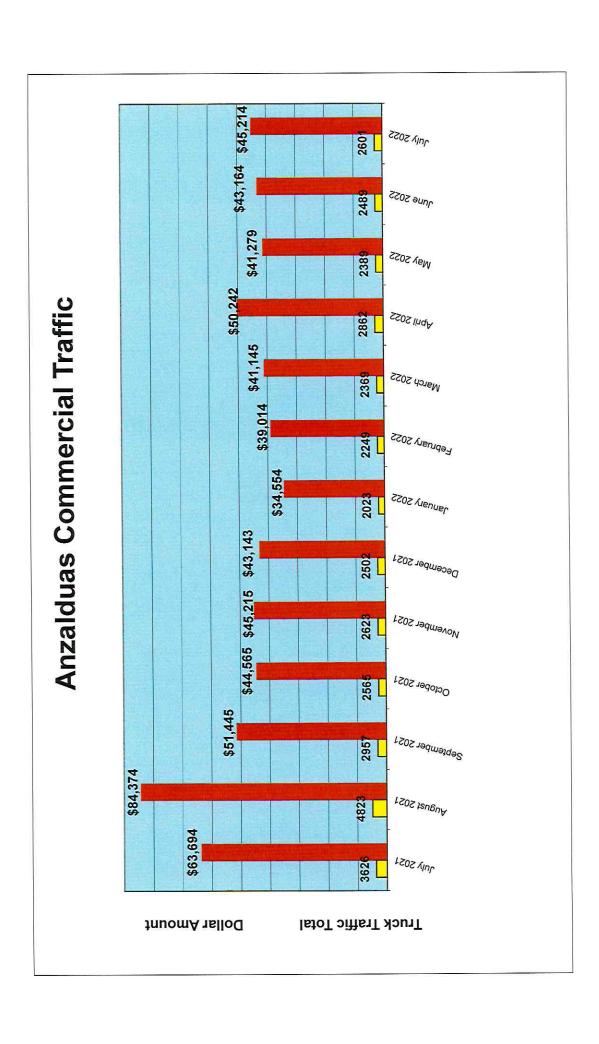

Comparison with Budget

Total revenues, as reflected on page 4, for the month of June are \$318,894. Revenues were \$157,270 better than budget for the month. Toll revenues were \$360,246 for the month. Toll revenues were \$108,496 more than budget for the month. June's monthly expenses were \$56,855 or (\$37,742) less than budget for the month.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MCALLEN EXPRESSING SUPPORT OF COSTS OF PROJECT FROM OBLIGATIONS TO BE ISSUED BY THE ANZALDUAS INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the CITY OF MCALLEN, TEXAS (the "City") hereby determines that it is necessary and desirable for the Anzalduas International Bridge to (1) construct improvements and related infrastructure at the Anzalduas Bridge; and (2) pay fiscal, design and engineering fees in connection with such project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City expects that the total costs of the Project will be an amount not to exceed \$84,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City expects that the Anzalduas International Bridge will pay expenditures in connection with the issuance of obligations to finance the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF MCALLEN, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. EXPECTATION TO INCUR DEBT. The City reasonably expects the Anzalduas International Bridge to incur debt, as one or more series of obligations, with an aggregate maximum principal amount currently estimated not to exceed \$63,000,000.00 with a 30-year financing term, the proceeds of which are expected to be used for the purpose of paying the costs of the Project.

SECTION 2. SUPPORT TO INCUR DEBT. The City finds, considers, and declares that the issuance of obligations by the Anzalduas International Bridge to finance the Project for the payment of such expenditures will be appropriate and consistent with the lawful objectives of the City and the Anzalduas International Bridge and, as such, chooses to declare its support for the issuance of obligations by the Anzalduas International Bridge to fund improvements and related infrastructure of the Anzalduas Bridge.

SECTION 3. PUBLIC RECORD. The City Commission directs that this Resolution shall be maintained as a public record available for inspection by all persons in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 552, Texas Government Code, and that no later than 30 days after this date, this Resolution will be made available for inspection by all members of the general public at the offices of the City.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF MCALLEN AND ANZALDUAS INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE

This Memorandum of Understanding is made and entered into on this the 4th day of August 2022 by and between the CITY OF MCALLEN, Texas (hereinafter referred to as "McALLEN") and the ANZALUDAS INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE (hereinafter referred to as the "BRIDGE") as follows.

WHEREAS, McALLEN, a political subdivision located in Hidalgo County, Texas, and BRIDGE desire to create this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") in support of the Anzalduas International Bridge Port of Entry Northbound Commercial Inspection project at the BRIDGE to create a more direct, safe, and efficient route between the Rio Grande Valley and Mexico and all other functions and services required or authorized by the laws of the State of Texas, under the terms and conditions prescribed in this MOU; and,

WHEREAS, the Anzalduas International Bridge Port of Entry Northbound Commercial Inspection project to be performed are functions and/or services which each of the parties hereto have independent authority to perform and authority to pursue; and,

WHEREAS, MCALLEN entered into a contract with S&B Infrastructure LTD in January 2020 for professional services in connection with the project at the BRIDGE; and

WHEREAS, both McAllen and BRIDGE named herein are desirous of entering into this MOU; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, McAllen and BRIDGE, in consideration of the mutual covenants expressed hereinafter, agree as follows:

- 1. BRIDGE agrees to reimburse and pay MCALLEN in full for all costs paid in connection with project at the BRIDGE to be performed by S&B Infrastructure LTD under the above-described contract with MCALLEN.
- 4. **Duration of MOU**: The term of this MOU shall continue in full force and effect until payment from BRIDGE to MCALLEN has been made in full.
- 5. **Primary Contacts**: The parties intend that the repayment obligation pertaining to the above-described project under this MOU shall be carried out in the most efficient manner possible. The parties intend to designate individuals that will serve as primary contacts between the parties. The parties intend that, to the maximum extent possible and unless otherwise approved by the other party, all significant communications between the parties shall be made through the primary contacts or their designees.
