Net income, as reflected on page 3, for the month of December is \$906,120 or a 52.92% increase compared to last year. Toll revenues were \$1,052,186 for the month, 11.86% increase over last year same time. Expenses were \$431,523 or an 6.92% increase compared to last year.

Comparison with Budget

Revenues, as reflected on page 5, for the month of December are \$974,974. These revenues were \$125,724 better than budget for the month. Toll revenues were \$1,052,186 for the month. Toll revenues were \$142,397 better than budget for the month. Administrative and operating expenses were \$362,669 for the month. Administrative and operating expenses were (\$72,897) less than budget for the month.

On a monthly basis, the City of McAllen's Finance Department emails the aggregate balances and calculations of Board Advance A, B, and the Special Startup Fund to the Finance Directors for the City of Mission and the City of Hidalgo. In addition, this information is presented on a quarterly basis to Bridge Board members of the Toll Bridge System, which includes the Hidalgo-McAllen Bridge and the Anzalduas Bridge.

As of December 31, 2022, the following advances of funds are due from the Anzalduas Bridge System to the Hidalgo-McAllen Bridge System.

1. **Special and Startup Fund Advance:** This advance is a result of expenses relating to obtaining the Anzalduas Bridge Presidential Permit and for the design, construction costs, operation expenses of the Anzalduas Bridge, and initial debt service on bonds related to the Anzalduas Bridge. Interest accrues at the rate of 4.74%.

The amount in the table below is Mission's share or 33 1/3% of the debt service that has been paid by the City of McAllen. The City of McAllen will continue to service the debt until the Anzalduas Bridge System generates enough revenue to service the debt.

The McAllen-Hidalgo International Bridge offers 4 turnstile pedestrian lanes for travelers walking south into Reynosa. In 2022, more than 1 million pedestrian used these turnstiles collecting over \$1 million in revenues.

In past months these turnstiles have been breaking down and at times are inoperable causing delays in pedestrian traffic. We have had them worked on and the recommendation is to replace them with newer turnstiles.

Attached is the cost of \$\$61,755 to replace these turnstiles and the necessary software/hardware to connect them to our toll revenue reporting system.

Staff recommends approval.
