#### Comparison with Prior Year

Net income, as reflected on page 3, for the month of December is \$592,526 or a 62% increase compared to last year. Toll revenues were \$940,659 for the month, 84% increase over last year same time. Expenses were \$403,583 or a 11% increase. The increase in expense is primarily due to additional repairs completed to the bridge's toll revenue equipment.

#### Comparison with Budget

Net income, as reflected on page 5, for the month of December is \$680,838. Net income was (\$185,367) less than budget for the month. The reason for this was that GSA's lease payment did not post in December. Toll revenues were \$940,659 for the month. Toll revenues were \$30,870 more than budget for the month. Administrative and operating expenses were \$315,271 for the month. Administrative and operating expenses were (\$39,493) more than budget for the month. The primary reason was overtime in staffing.

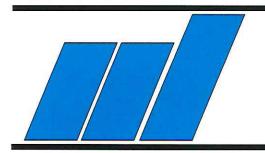

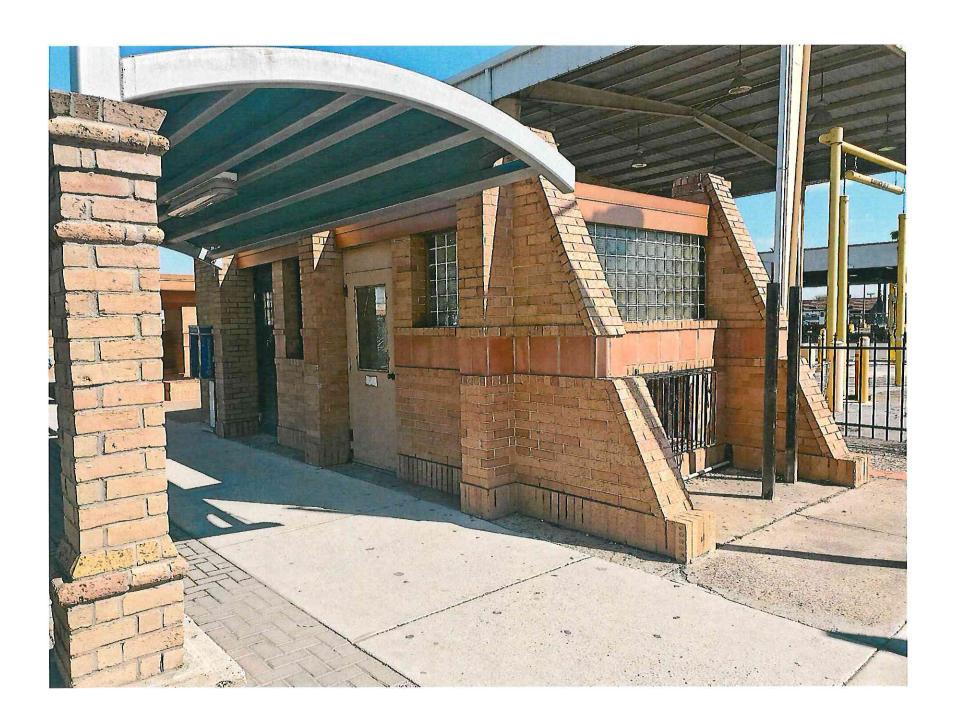
