Net income before depreciation, as reflected on page 4, for the month of November is \$947,140. Net income was \$22,268 better than budget for the month. Toll revenues were \$979,835 for the month. Toll revenues were \$5,567 better than budget for the month. Administrative and operating expenses were \$268,590 for the month. ### GOAL

This item is submitted for consideration and approval of the Construction Documents and then authorization to proceed to Bidding phase of the project for the above mentioned project.

### **EXPLANATION**

Milnet Architectural Services, PLLC is concluding their Design Construction Documents efforts. According to the contract language, the consultants require Design Construction Documents approval before proceeding to the next phase of design.

The scope of services for this phase is the project site encompasses 1.0 acre in the northeast corner of the existing port which is located at 1026 South International Blvd., Hidalgo, Texas. The site is approximately .5 miles north of the McAllen-Hidalgo-Reynosa International Bridge on the Rio Grande River and is bordered to the north Bridge Street and to the west by South International Blvd (US Hwy 281), both in the City of Hidalgo. The site is currently part of the developed Port of Entry. Scope of work includes the expansion of four existing pedestrian lanes into 10 lanes, along with the expansion of the existing quarantine rooms to hold almost double the amount of people. Renovations include relocation of existing interior storefronts and existing interior walls, doors, and windows. Existing lighting will be relocated accordingly to the new layout, all new electrical for lane booths is to be provide from overhead to minimize disturbance to existing foundation and expedite installation. Two large existing offices will be converted into three smaller to aid in more private interview processing, a large storage room will also be added for the much needed detainee valuables storage. For a estimated total construction cost of \$498,284.05.

The overall design includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Architectural
- Interior
- Mechanical Engineering
- Cost Estimation
