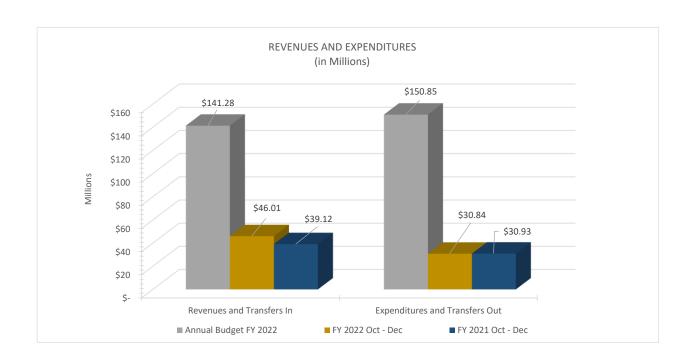
As of December 31, 2021

The FSR reports revenues by major category and expenditures by function and department. This report focuses on the City's primary operating fund (General Fund). It accounts for all financial transactions of the City, except those required to be accounted for in another fund.

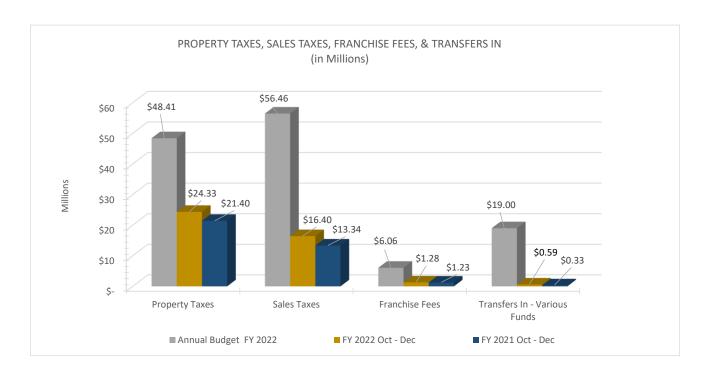

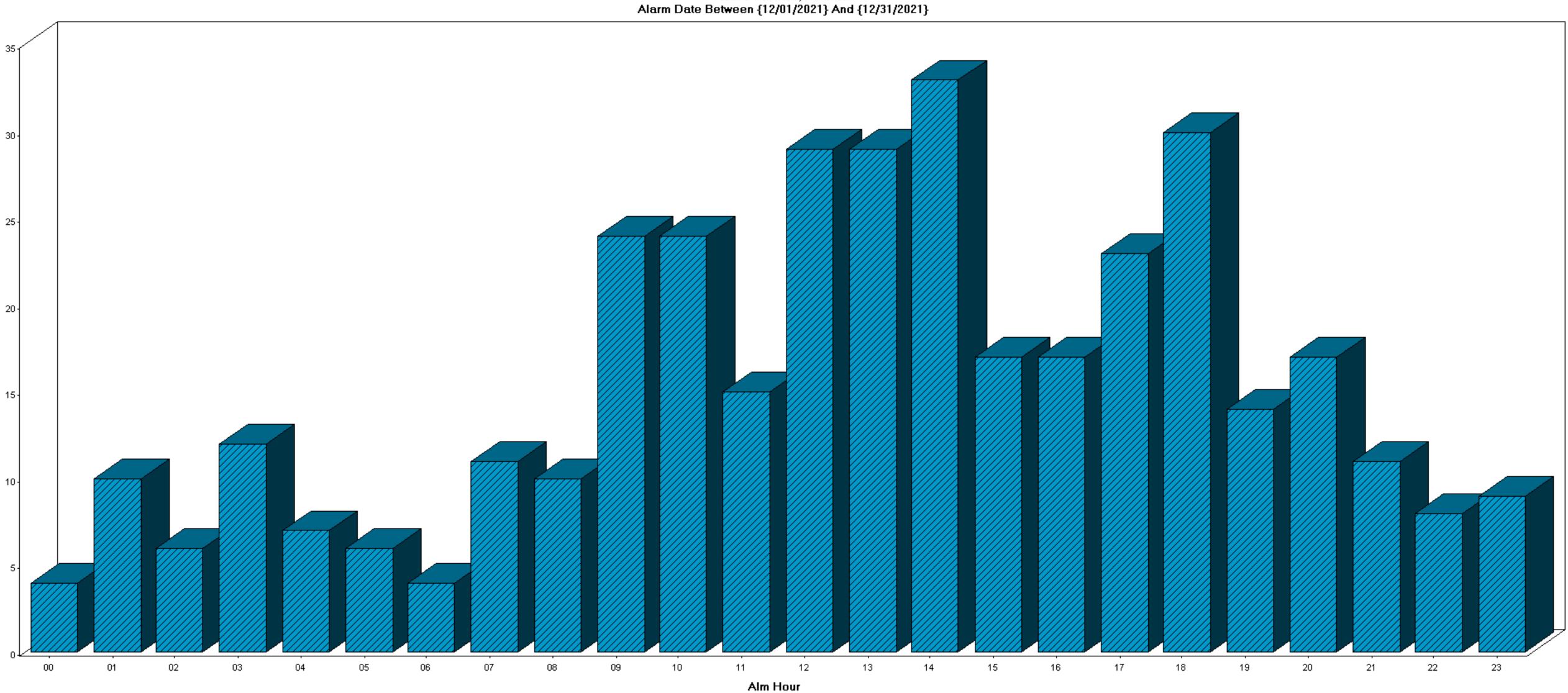

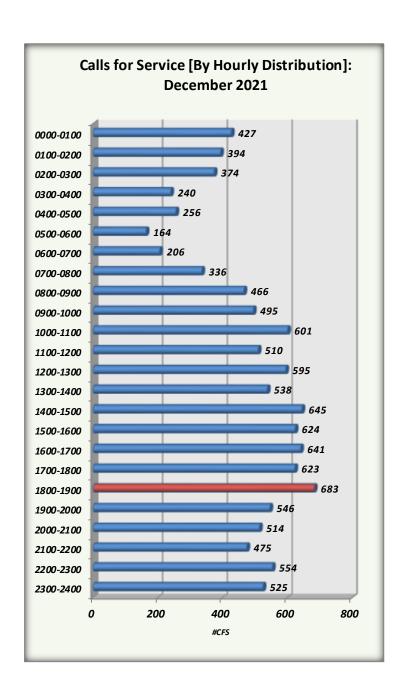


Monthly Calls for Service December 2021

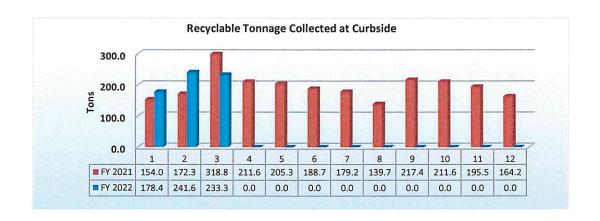
