McAllen Parks & Recreation Opens Summer 2020 Program Registration

The Summer 2020 Activity Guide is now online

The McAllen Parks & Recreation Department has published their new Summer 2020 Activity Guide. The programs featured are in a weekly summer camp format at each of the three McAllen community centers: Lark Community Center, located at 2601 Lark Avenue; PalmView Community Center, located at 3401 Jordan Rd W; and Las Palmas Community Center, located at 1921 N. 25th Street.

Community centers closed to the public on Monday, March 16, 2020 in response to COVID-19. Since that date, the department has launched a new ESPORTS program, served over 750 meals to McAllen Seniors daily, and created McAllen Parks & Recreation Unplugged, a weekly series of at home programs. To prepare for Summer 2020, Parks & Recreation staff worked to determine how to welcome participants back to community centers for programming and social interaction with their peers, while keeping top of mind that the health and wellness of participants, parents, and staff was of the utmost importance.

Each community center is offering 10 sessions of one week each. Session 1 begins on June 1, 2020 with registration opening on May 23, 2020 at 7:00 a.m. Space for each camp is limited, early registration is recommended.
