Three Charged in Motor Vehicle Thefts

McAllen Police Officers investigate reports of stolen vehicles. McAllen Officers report on January 2, 2025 a stolen 2021 GMC Sierra AT4 model pickup from a business parking area on the 600 block of E. Expressway 83, in McAllen, TX. On this same day, a 2021 Chevrolet Silverado pickup was also reported stolen from a business parking area on the 2700 block of S. 10th Street, in McAllen, TX. McAllen Officers report on January 6, 2025 a stolen GMC Denali 2500 model pickup stolen from a parking area of a business on the 800 block of Convention Center Blvd., in McAllen, TX.

On January 6, 2025, through coordinated efforts with local, state, and federal partnerships, McAllen Police Investigators and Officers were able to locate the stolen GMC Denali 2500 pickup in the Harlingen area and arrested three suspects. **Jose Enrique Torres**, **Jessica Guerra**, and **Luis Enrique Acuna** were arrested in the reported Theft of the GMC Denali 2500 pickup. and suspects to the Thefts of the GMC Sierra AT4 and Chevrolet Silverado pickups.
